TASK: HUMAN RIGHTS IN HEALTH & SOCIAL CARE

It's vital that we safeguard our Human Rights. The idea of a standard set of rights came about as a result of the terrible atrocities committed after WW2 and they did not enter British law until 1998. The video below takes you through a whistle stop tour of how the Human Rights Act protects people in the UK today that use or work in health, social or child care settings.

The teacher can use the video and pause it to allow students to complete the tasks outlined within it. Or teachers can watch the video prior and make their way through the presentation themselves without the need to use the video.

The tasks involve mainly discussion, watching very short video clips and the sharing of ideas and opinions.

Students will need access to a pen and A4 paper. Staff will need access to the WWW and a board to display the presentation and videos.
