TASK

Sociology Tasks:

- 1. Define the terms **crime** and **deviance**.
- 2. State whether you think an array of different actions are crimes, deviant acts, both, or neither.
- 3. Outline things that may or may not be crimes at one time but not another, or in one place but not another.
- 4. Provide reasons that crime statistics on the charts may not be valid.

Psychology Tasks:

- 1. Using the PowerPoint slides (slide 14/15) access the image of 'Johnny aged 14 who has recently been arrested for several crimes'
- 2. Using the images on the worksheet, annotate with suggestions as to why Johnny may have committed these crimes
- 3. Using slide 16—check your own suggestions with those in the table—annotate whether it is a 'Biological Reason' or a 'Non-Biological Reason' add any reasons in you haven't included already!
- 4. Move to slide 17—identify ways you think we could reduce criminality—think about how you could tackle some of the reasons you have generated
- 5. Check your suggestions on slide 18
