TASK

Stem cell research task: Should stem cells be used to treat Alzheimer's?

Students are to work in groups of two or three to produce a poster to include information on the use of stem cells as a cure for Alzheimer's. Students are to include referencing of the sources of information they have used in their work.

Your poster should include information on the following points:

- What are stem cells?
- Where are stem cells usually found?
- Explain how stem cells may be used to treat Alzheimer's disease.
- Discuss the ethical reasons why stem cell research should not be used.
- Contrast the ethical reasons why stem cell research should be used.
- Evaluate the risks and benefits of using stem cells in Alzheimer's treatment.
