TASK

Two Roads—Two Ways Of Reading

What is the difference between studying English Literature and English Language at A-Level?

In this session, students will be able to apply the skills they would use in the two different disciplines to a single text, *The Road Not Taken* by Robert Frost.

Our **Literature** specialist staff will guide the students down one path, interpreting the text as we might in an A-Level Literature class, placing it within its social and historical context and applying different critical frameworks to draw out interpretations of this ambiguous piece.

Our **Language** experts will then show students the other path, thinking about systematic analysis of stylistics to help students consider how form and structure work to foreground meaning.

In English A-Level, two roads diverge. Which will you take?
